Parental Support

Wandsworth Lions FC is a grassroots football club, and like all grassroots club we cannot run a successful club without the support of parents/guardians. Our members are asked to volunteer for at least one position within the club to help with the running of the club and make the players experience enjoyable.

- Manager (Saturdays)
- Assistant Manager (Saturdays)
- Linesman (Saturday & Sunday)
- Match Stewards – responsible for match cards and parent control

- Community and Charity Organisers

Support On Match Day

With a hope of developing all Wandsworth Lions FC players into footballers and/or young responsible people, guardian/parent are advice to encourage all players on and off the pitch.

Attendance to match days to show players support are welcome, however if players are discourage or guardian/parent are abusive to players, coaches and/or match officials, they will be ask to leave the playing area.

Rules and Consequences

At Wandsworth Lions FC we take seriously the development of players in our club. Therefore, our members are asked to follow club rules when joining the club. We also ask and encourage guardian/parent to inform staff when a player breaches rules outside of Wandsworth Lions FC environment.

Below players and parents/guardians can find rules which are expected to be followed as a member of the club.

General Expectations (Rules)

- Parent/guardian must pay club fees by 7th July (see page 5 for more details).
- Players must respect staff of Wandsworth Lions FC.
- Players must respect guardian/parents and house rules.
- Players must have an average of 80% or above school attendance as well as good school behaviour.
- Players are prohibited to have any participation in any illegal activities.

Training Expectations (Rules)

- Parent/guardian must pay club fees by 7th July (see page 5 for more details).
- Players are expected to attend training – If unable to attend, guardian/parent must inform coach/manager at latest 1 hour before training starts.
- Players are expected to arrive for training 10 minutes before training to get change.
- Players must wear proper training wear – Centre of excellence training top, yellow shorts/black tracksuit bottom, blue socks, shin pads, astro trainers and firm ground football boots.
- Players are advice to bring drinks with them to training in order to avoid dehydration. No fizzy or energy drinks allowed.

Match Expectations (Rules)

- Players must bring proper Wandsworth Lions FC match kit – Home and away (both) match top, yellow shorts, blue socks, shin pads and firm ground football boots (plastic/moulded).
- Players (U12-U6) are expected to wear **predominately black** firm ground football boots (plastic/moulded) for matches.
- Players are expected to conduct themselves in a good manner before, during and after a match.
- Players are expected to arrive on time for matches – time will be set by age group manager.

Breach of General Expectations (Consequences)

- Player/s will be warned and failure to correct behaviour will resort in suspension until staff receive apology. Further disrespect after suspension will resort in player being asked to leave the team.
- Player/s will be warned and failure to correct behaviour at home will resort in suspension until guardian/parent deems behaviour acceptable.
- Player/s will not be allowed to play until guardian/parent deems school attendance and/or behaviour acceptable.
- Player/s will be expelled from the team if found participating in any illegal activities.

Breach of Training Expectation (Consequences)

- Player/s will not be allowed to participate in training or matches until club fees are made(see page 5 for more details).
- Selection for matches will be based on training attendance; therefore failure to attend training could resort in missing weekend match. However if player/s inform manager, he/she may be considered for selection.
- If proper training wear is not brought; players will not be allowed to train (health and safety) and therefore may not be selected for match.

Breach of Match Expectation (Consequences)

- Player/s will not be allowed to participate in training or matches until full payment is made.
- Failure to bring proper match wear will resort in player/s not being selected for the match unless extra match wear is available.
- If player/s (U12-U16) fails to wear **predominately black** football boots (plastic/moulded), he/she will be warned. Continue breach of this will result in the player being suspended. Further breach after suspension will resort in player/s being asked to leave the team.
- Failure to arrive on time for a match will resort in the player starting as a SUB (beach). Continue lateness will resort in the player being suspended for games.
- If a player fails to conduct himself in a good manner before, during and/or after the game, player will be suspended for either the present game, or the following game.

Club Fees

Club fees are vital for the running of the club. Without it players will not be able to train as well as participate in the league, cup and/or any competition they are eligible for. Whilst we do not charge for matches, payment contributes to match necessities.

Below are what fees will go towards:

- End of season presentation
- Training facilities hire cost
- Match facilities hire cost
- Registration into league
- London FA Affiliation
- London FA Public Insurance
- London FA Personal Insurance
- Registration into cup competition
- Referee fee – for home league matches and cup away matches

Saturday team fee

Below are the cost for all age groups (option 1).

- Under 7s and U8s = £480 ... Friday training.
- Under 9s and U10 = £500 ... Friday training.

***Friday training mandatory. Fridays training concludes at the end of April.**

Below are the cost for all age groups (option 2).

- Under 7s and U8s = £42 per month + £230 ... Wednesday & Friday training.
- Under 9s and U10 = £42 per month + £230 ... Wednesday & Friday training.

*** Twice a week training optional. Fridays training concludes at the end of April.**

Friday training fee can be made in one lump sum or in two instalment (3 months apart) directly to club account. Payment need to be made, or instalment started by 31st July.

If attending twice a week, (Wednesday) training fee is to be made as monthly payment (subscription) via our website. Parent/guardian must make payment and/or set up payment by 6th September.

Please note fees do not cover kits. Training and match kits are purchasable from 'Direct Soccer', our supplier. See page 6 for information on required kits.

Match and Training Kit

All players representing Wandsworth Lions FC must have training and match kits. It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to ensure their child/children has the required training and match kit before the start of the season (1st September).

Below are the required kits all players MUST have.

- WLFC Centre Of Excellence (Training top) – All players
- Wandsworth Lions FC Home Kit (Blue) – Outfield players
- Wandsworth Lions FC Away Kit (Yellow) – Outfield players
- Wandsworth Lions FC Keeper Kit (Grey) – Keepers only
- Wandsworth Lions FC Shorts Kit (Yellow) – All Players
- Wandsworth Lions FC Socks Kit (Blue) – All Players

Optional kit

- Wandsworth Lions FC Winter coat (Black) – recommend for winter.
- Wandsworth Lions FC Scarf (Black)
- Wandsworth Lions FC Beanie Hat (Blue and Yellow)
